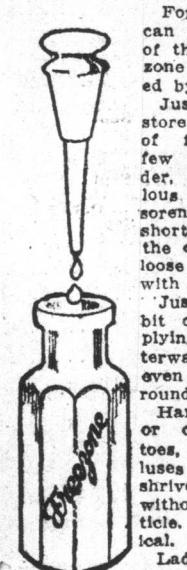

Testing Men for Army Tasks

Camp Meade, Md., doesn't have professors of psychology and education among its soldiers in vain. Dr. Leonard Keene Hirschberg, a professor of psychology at the University of Pennsylvania, is performing some of the most important work in the world at the moment. He is testing the mental aptitudes of the soldiers at Camp Meade, and his work is of the highest importance.

The board maintains that the method employed is a great time-saver, and that men who are incapable of performing certain pieces of assigned work are weeded out by the intelligence tests and relieved of the duties of that kind of work. Thus the time of the officers and the time of the American army is saved.

The test consists of a series of mental examinations. The first of these is the "Army Alpha," which is a test of the soldier's general intelligence. It is a test of the soldier's ability to understand and follow directions, to read and write, and to solve simple problems.
