County Court Sittings, for trial of issues in fact.—June 11,

County and Surrogate Courts.—Terms: Commence Mondays—January 7, April 1, July 1, October 7.—January 6, 1879.

Judges Chambers.—Mondays and Thursdays—and on other days specially appointed.

Court for Speedy Trial, by judge, without a jury, in criminal cases—not being capital felonies, &c.—Sittings as occasion may require after commitment of prisoners.
