

## Times and Places of Sittings of the several Civil and Criminal Courts.

---

**General (Criminal) Sessions**—June 11, December 10.

**County Court Sittings**, for trial of issues in fact.—June 11, Dec. 10.

**County Court Sittings**, for trial of issues in fact—*without a jury*.—April 1, October 7.

**County and Surrogate Courts.—Terms**: Commence Mondays—January 7, April 1, July 1, October 7.—January 6, 1879.

**Judges Chambers**.—Mondays and Thursdays—and on other days specially appointed.

**Court for Speedy Trial**, *by judge, without a jury*, in criminal cases—not being capital felonies, &c.—Sittings as occasion may require after commitment of prisoners.

**Under the Insolvent Act**.—Sittings on Monday and Thursday in each week upon appointment of Judge—except in vacation, (July 1st to August 21st.)

(All the above Courts sit in the Court House, *Barrie*.)

**Courts of Appeal—Assessment**—(From Courts of Revision.)—Times and places of Sittings fixed by the Judge as occasion requires, between July 6th and July 31st.

**Courts of Appeal—Voters' Lists**—(For Revision and Correction.)—Times and places of Sittings fixed by the Judge as occasion requires, between August 1st and December 31st.
