29th.—Carters to carry a sufficient load.

30th.—Carters not to loiter about unemployed in any other place than on stand aforesaid.

31st.—Carters to be able-bodied men.

32nd.—No carter or cab-driver to unreasonably or cruelly beat any horse or other animal under his care.

33rd.—Not to cart water or other articles on a Sunday, except in case of fire or other emergency.

40th.—Mayor or any two Aldermen, can suspend or displace any driver of any public vehicle for any misconduct, who cannot be afterwards employed as such without permission from the Mayor for the time being, or the said Alderman by whom he was displaced.

41st.—Persons offending against any provisions of this Act liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds, nor less than two shillings and six-pence, to be levied on goods and chattels in default of payment of fine and costs.
