Memorandum for
Deputy Minister:-

The Fisher River Indian Reserve was surveyed in 1878 and at that time the greater portion of it was subdivided into a number of narrow river lots. This subdivision survey, Mr. J.K. McLean says, is practically obliterated. He also says that an error occurred in that survey in connection with the lot occupied by the Hudson Bay Company.

We have a number of surveys on Lake Winnipeg which have been put off from time to time for many years past. I think we might arrange for Mr. McLean to undertake the work in that section next year. With your approval we will have the survey of the whole or part of the subdivision of the Fisher River Reserve re-established, or re-arranged, as may be thought advisable; at the same time the error in the Hudson Bay Company's lot can be rectified. I am unable to state the cost of this survey, I think however that \$800.00 will cover the whole cost of the said particular survey.
