

NOTES OF THE MONTH.

MARCH, or Martius, was the first month in the oldest Roman Calendar, and was named after Mars, the reputed father of Romulus. Numa made it the third. The sun enters Aries, the ram, on the 20th; and about the 21st the vernal equinox occurs with heavy gales. The 1st is St. David's Day; the 17th, St. Patrick's; the 25th is the Annunciation, or Lady Day.
