### SOLDIERS TO DO HANDICRAFT WORK

Demand for Hand Loan Products  
Has Given Rise to Plan For  
Returned Men

Montreal, Nov. 2.—The demand for  
the artistic products from hand looms  
for the villages in Quebec and the sur-  
rounding provinces, has given rise to a plan  
to employ disabled Canadian soldiers  
who find an occupation which not only  
affords a good living, but is within the  
scope of their diminished strength.

Capt. T. R. MacKeen, district voca-  
tional officer of the Military Hospitals  
Commission, conferring with Mrs. James  
Deek, for many years president of the  
Canadian Handicraft Guild, in Mon-  
treal, whose aim is to foster the artistic  
hand crafts of the peasant settlements  
in Canada, has made arrangements to  
teach the men textile weaving on hand  
looms as vocational training during their  
convalescence in the Military Conval-  
escent hospitals. The start has been  
very successful among the men in the  
three hospitals in Montreal where "bed  
cases," are being treated.

Textiles in Demand.  
The demand for hand-woven textiles

PREPARE FOR FEW  
STORMY YEARS, ADVICE  
OF BANK PRESIDENT

Montreal, Nov. 5.—President William  
Molson MacPherson, of the Molsons  
Bank, in his address to the shareholders  
at the sixty-second annual meeting here  
today, referred to the expenditures for  
munitions and food supplies in connection  
with the war and suggested the idea  
of business men to prepare for the change  
that will come when the war is over.  
That they can weather a few stormy  
years, should they come.

The directors were re-elected as fol-  
lows: William Molson MacPherson, Wm.  
M. Birks, W. A. Black, E. J. Chamber-  
lain, F. W. Molson, George E. Drum-  
mond and S. H. Ewing. At a subse-  
quent meeting of the directors Mr. Mac-  
Pherson was re-elected president and S.  
H. Ewing, vice-president.

The total assets of the Molsons Bank  
are \$55,780,218, an increase of \$5,638,114  
as compared with a year ago. Deposits  
are \$22,774,550, with \$2,284,000 of the  
gain coming under the head of deposits.

Net profits are \$615,514, an increase of  
\$83,458 over the previous year and \$99,  
321 higher than two years ago.
