POPULATION.

Great interest is manifested every year in the estimate we are accustomed to make as to the population of Winnipeg. Our estimate is based on the number of names in the Directory. Last year we estimated the population to be 49,000. This year the increase of names indicates a population of 54,778, a very satisfactory increase. Now that we have passed the first 50,000, six or seven years more should see Winnipeg well over the 100,000 mark. It must be remembered, in comparing our estimate with the City Assessor's estimate, that ours is one year ahead of his, and includes all that we can find within our city.
