WORK OF SCOTLAND YARD.

London, Aug. 7.—(By Mail)—All the most valuable property—including two portraits by Gainsborough, worth nearly thousands of pounds—stolen in the raid on the collection of Henry Cecil Sutton, at Benham Park, near Newbury, more than two months ago, have been recovered by Scotland Yard detectives reports "The London Daily Express."

The police state that a man named Rogers is under detention. The Gainsboroughs are pictures of Mrs. Sutton's ancestors. One is a painting of Anne Sutton, and the other a portrait of Richard Sutton. Four miniatures by Grimaldi and two panels of women in Elizabethan dress were found by the police with the portraits. Benham Park was entered by burglars during the night when the household was asleep.
