

Meat of any kind may be perseved in a temperature of from 80 degrees to 100 degrees for a period of ten days after it has been soaked in a solution of one pint of salt dissolved in four gallons of cold water and one-half gallon of a solution bisulphate of calcium. By repeating this process the preservation may be extended by an addition of a solution of gelatine or the white of an egg to the salt and water.
