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Visually adjusting the field of view is accomplished by:-

- I. Remove the gear box and shutter from the camera body.
- II. Place the body and cone in camera mount and secure.
- III. Place a sheet of ground glass (ground side down) on the pressure glass and swing camera by means of the adjustment knobs on the camera mount, until horizon line is parallel and approximately 1" down on picture apertures.
- IV. Lock mount adjustment screws and note position of camera body in frame.
- V. Remove camera body and replace gear box and shutter.
- VI. Place camera back in mount adjust to noted position and lock.
- VII. Test camera operation.
 - (a) Independently of bomb circuit
 - (b) Through bomb circuit. This test should only be made when an armorer or electrician is present.

6. LOADING THE CAMERA.

- I. Electrically operate camera until 17 exposures have been run off then stop by removing power plug from wall receptacle.
- II. Place loaded magazine on camera and run off remaining three exposures by placing power plug.

The camera is then ready for operation through the bomb key.

NOTE: These instructions are tentative and it may be advantageous to alter or deviate from them.
