It is all their wish that they should regularly attend on Sundays tir respective places of worship, and receive such other religious truction as their parents or guardians may desire. I have to quest that you will be so good as to lat me know whether you sire your _____ to attend such Daily Prayers in the ollege, and that you will also mention the Minister under hose charge you wish to place him.

The Council will afford every facility for the carrying but of your intentions, and, with this view, will exercise such control over your ----- during his residence, as may be best calculated to effect your wishes. In the event of your not informing me of your desire on the subject, the Council will assume that you have no objection to his being required to attend the Daily Prayers of the College, and will exercise an oversight as to his attendance on the ministrations of a Clergyman of the Denomination to which he belongs.
