**TO LOAD HARD COAL.**

Sch William L. Elkins, Captain Palmer, arrived at Montreal, Conn., last Thursday from St. John with a cargo of lumber. After discharging the schooner will proceed to New York to load hard coal for this port.

**BATTLE LINE MOVEMENTS.**

**SMALLEST THREE-MASTERS.**
