The Course of Study is exclusively commercial. Although the French and English languages are

nearly on the same fooling, Mathematics, Book-Keeping, Forms of notes, Letters, Receipte, &c., are taught only in English. Pupils may be admitted even at the age of six ; the

juniors have a special rule to follow; their teacher is a clergyman, and they receive, simultaneously with elementary education, the special religious cares

lrequent non attendance without just cause, render pupils subject to expulsion. Parent: must make known the cause of the non-attendance of their children.
