

BILL.

An Act to appropriate the moneys arising from Duties on Tavern Licences, in the County and City of Montreal, towards defraying the cost of the new Court House, to be erected in the City of Montreal.

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide more ample funds for defraying the cost of erecting the new Court House at Montreal, than are provided by the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intitled, "*An Act to make provision for the erection or repair of Court Houses and Gaols, at certain places in Lower Canada,*" under which the said Court House is to be erected:—Be it therefore enacted, &c.;

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,
 10 That for and notwithstanding any thing in the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intitled, "*An Act to provide for the payment of claims arising out of the Rebellion and Invasion in Upper Canada, and to appropriate the duties on Tavern Licences to local purposes,*" the moneys arising after the passing of this Act, from the Duties on Licences to keep Houses of Public Entertainment, within the County and City of Montreal, shall be and are hereby appropriated towards defraying the cost of erecting the new Court House in the City of
 20 Montreal, under the Act mentioned in the preamble to this Act, and the other expenses incident thereto, and the principal and interest of the Debentures issued or to be issued under the said Act, and the expenses of keeping the said Court House and its appurtenances, in thorough
 25 repair and order; and such moneys shall be paid, applied and accounted for accordingly by the proper officers, and no part thereof shall be paid over to the Treasurer of any Municipal Division whatsoever.

Notwithstanding any thing in 8 Vict., c. 72, the duties on certain Tavern Licences shall be appropriated towards defraying charges under 12 Vict., c. 112.
