An Act to restrain the Trade and Commerce of the Province of *Massachusetts Bay*, and *New Hampshire*, and Colonies of *Connecticut*, and *Rhode Island*, and *Providence Plantation*, in *North America*, to *Great Britain*, *Ireland*, and the *British Islands* in the *West Indies*, and to prohibit such Provinces and Colonies from carrying on any Fishery on the Banks of *Newfoundland*, or other Places therein mentioned, under certain Conditions and Limitations.



WHEREAS by an Act, made in the Twelfth Year of the Reign of King *Charles the Second*, intituled, *An Act for the encouraging and increasing of Shipping and Navigation*, and by several subsequent Acts of Parliament, which are now in Force, it is, amongst other Things, enacted, That for every Ship or Vessel which shall load any Commodities in those Acts particularly
