

The International Traineeship Exchange Program

What is a traineeship?

A traineeship is a period of employment in another country where students work in areas related to their field of study. A traineeship can last anywhere from 8 weeks to 18 months. This job is usually related to business management, economics, or computer science.

In order to go on a traineeship, local AIESEC members must raise jobs for international students in Fredericton. For every job raised here, one person from our local gets to go on a traineeship.

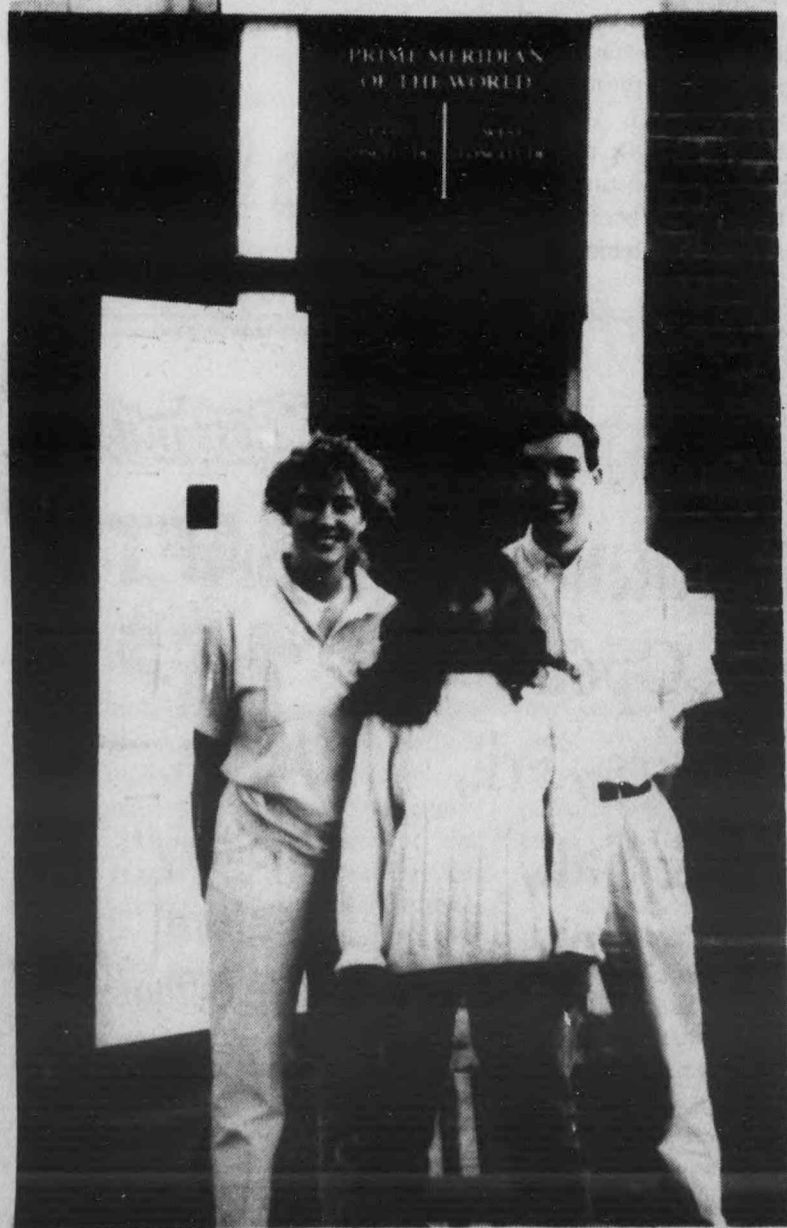
Any AIESEC member can apply to go on a traineeship. Who gets to go is determined by an interview with a ranking committee. This committee ranks applicants according to their past involvement in AIESEC.

Once the ranking is completed, the next stage is to match students to the jobs. There are two forms - an SN spec for the student, and a TN spec for the company. The company specifies the starting and finishing times of the traineeship, specialization required, and where the traineeship is going to be. The students fill out their qualifications, skills, time of availability, and the preferred location to work in.

These forms are matched by computer several times a year by the TARGET program.

After this process has been completed, all you have to do is prepare for your trip. This includes obtaining passports, plane tickets, working visas, and other necessary materials that will differ depending on your destination.

AIESEC Canada and the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) have an agreement known as ADAPT Programme, whereby the travel costs of a trainee going to a developing country are paid for. This is something to keep in mind when filling out your preferred destination.
