

- (c) The number of horse power which it is proposed to develop and use (1) within two years (2) within five years.
  - (d) The location of the water privileges applied for and a description of the land required in connection therewith.
  - (e) A description of the lands which would be submerged or otherwise affected by raising of the water.
  - (f) The height of the fall or rapid, the volume of water at high and low stages.
  - (g) The estimated capacity in horse power of the fall or rapid in its natural condition at low water stage.
  - (h) The method by which the applicant proposes to develop the water power.

On receipt of this information your application will be dealt with.

As to your application for an augmentation of the grant to the school, I regret to say that this matter cannot be dealt with at present, as the whole question of an increased grant to schools is under consideration and until a decision is come to in regard thereto it will not be possible to grant an increase in any individual case.
