

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant, with which you forwarded for payment voucher No 1411 for \$50.00 in favour of Mr Ferrest Leeder for vaccinating Indians, of the Cowichan Agency; and in reply I return herewith the triplicate copy of the voucher. The ~~same~~ charge of \$35.00 for the special journey made by meter car has been disallowed. A sub-voucher from the Meter Company was not attached to the voucher, nor has an explanation been given with respect to the said charge. If you consider that it was necessary for the doctor to engage an automobile, and if that mode of conveyance was as cheap as a livery, you may forward a separate voucher in support of the charge. Cheque No 1871 for \$15.00 is enclosed herewith in payment of the voucher, less the charge to which exception is taken.
