Answer required.

Sir,

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant relative to the fishing grounds on the shores of Lake Huron, between French Bay and Au Sable River; and in reply, to beg to enclose herewith copy of a letter from the Canadian Agent for the Saugeen River, in which he represents, inter alia, that all the fishing ground which is of any value has been taken over to white men, while the Indian ground occupied by the Indians is of little value.

On consideration of the manifest injustice done the Indians, I would add that, if possible, the suggestions made
