Please look in the Books if the cheque has been endorse or cashed by other person or signature on these lost stolen cheque and; another payments miss Kuskitwoo claim they soon from now she said we are getting this \$25.00 every six months and; the four dollars only once a year please inform the Indian Dept at Ottawa.
