In reply to your letter of the 15th Instant I beg to say that the description in Letters Patent to William Forbes issued on the 7th February 1863, is as follows;

All that parcel or tract of land situate
 • lying and being in the Township of South Cay-
 • uga, in the County of Haldimand, of our said
 • Province, containing by admeasurement 95 acres,
 • be the same more or less, which said parcel or
 • tract of land may be otherwise known as fol-
 • lows, that is to say, being composed of the South
 • part of Lot No 31 in the 4th Concession of the
 • aforesaid Township of South Cayuga, that is to
 • say, Commencing at the South East angle of the
 • said Lot, thence South 73 degrees West ten
 • chains 50 links to the limit between the Town-
 • ships of South Cayuga and Haldimand, thence North
 • 62 degrees, 30 minutes West, 15 chains 45 links
 • more or less to the Western limit of the said
 • Lot, thence North 17 degrees West 37 chains, 15
 • links more or less to the South Eastern limit
 • of the Jones Tract, thence North 27 degrees 30
 • minutes East 4 chains and 94 links, more or
 • less to a line running South 73 degrees West
 • from the limit between the North and South
 • halves of Lot No 28 in the said Concession,
 thence
