Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 15th instant I beg to say that the description in Letters Patent to William Forbes issued on the 7th February 1863, is as follows; "All that parcel or tract of land situate

- * lying and being in the Township of South Cayuga, in the County of Haldimand, of our said Province, containing by measurement 95 acres,
- * be the same more or less, which said parcel or tract of land may be otherwise known as follows, that is to say, being composed of the South
- * part of Lot No 31 in the 4th Concession of the aforesaid Township of South Cayuga, that is to say, Commencing at the South East angle of the
- * said Lot, thence South 75 degrees West ten
- * chains 50 links to the limit between the Townships of South Cayuga and Rainham, thence North 52 degrees 30 minutes West, 13 chains 45 links
- * more or less to the Western limit of the said Lot, thence North 17 degrees West 37 chains, 10
- * links more or less to the South Western limit of the Jones Trust, thence North 27 degrees 30 minutes West 4 chains and 96 links, more or less to a line running South 75 degrees West from the limit between the North and South halves of Lot No 28 in the said Concession,
