With reference to the Agricultural and Industrial Statistics of your agency, I beg to draw your attention to Table 4, Land and Private Fencing and Buildings in which you neglect to account for the total area of the reserves in the columns provided. You state the area of the reserves to be 9½ acres and 450 acres respectively. These areas should be accounted for under the headings "Underwood", "Cleared but not cultivated", and "Under actual cultivation."
