C - 3 I also produce M.F.B. 1482, Certificate of Incidental Expenses incurred by the escort while apprehending the accused. M.F.B. 1482, is read, marked Exhibit "I", signed by the President and attached to the proceedings. I also produce, M.F.B. 375, Record of the Declaration of a Court of Inquiry assembled at Fredericton, N.B. to investigate the illegal absence of the accused. M.F.B. 375, is read, marked Exhibit "J", signed by the President and attached to the proceedings. THE DEFENDING OFFICER DECLINES TO CROSS-EXAMINE THIS WITNESS. IN THE OPINION OF THE COURT IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH RULE OF PROCEDURE 83 (B). WITNESS WITHDRAWS. Second Witness G-23412 Sergeant H. K. CRAIK, No. 70 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, C.A. being duly sworn, is for the prosecution examined by the prosecutor.
