- -Make a good choice.
- -Feed sufficiently, but economically.
- -House in a sanitary manner.
- -Raise the young with care until weaning time.
- -Make good use of dairy by-products for the young pigs.
- -Economize grain with pasture, green fodder and roots.
- -Manage rearing and fattening so that the hogs weigh about 200 lbs. when seven months old.
- -Breed your sows for a second litter in the autumn.
