HOW TO INCREASE THE PRODUCTION OF PORK

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- Keep one more sow.
- Make a good choice.
- Feed sufficiently, but economically.
- House in a sanitary manner.
- Raise the young with care until weaning time.
- Make good use of dairy by-products for the young pigs.
- Economize grain with pasture, green fodder and roots.
- Manage rearing and fattening so that the hogs weigh about 200 lbs. when seven months old.
- Breed your sows for a second litter in the autumn.

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
