JULY.—Muck is a valuable economizer of barn-yard manure. A layer of muck in the stable saturated with urine is nearly as good as the best solid excrement. A cord of muck thoroughly mixed with a cord of animal excrement, will make two cords of manure worth twice as much as the unmixed matter if left to leach and ferment in the usual manner. This mixture can be more equally scattered over a field, and its properties more equally diffused, a matter of very great importance. In the fall of the year, you may gather muck; mix during winter and spring Try the experiment, certainly it will cost something, but you may rely on ultimate profit.
