**GOSSIP.** 

Mr. Myron A. Gee, Selkirk, Ont. breeder of Barred Plymouth Rock fowls and Pekin ducks, in ordering a change in his advertisement, writes : "We have shipped on mail orders for hatching this season, through our advertisement, over 1,200 eggs; got our last order last week, and made the shipment August 1st.


