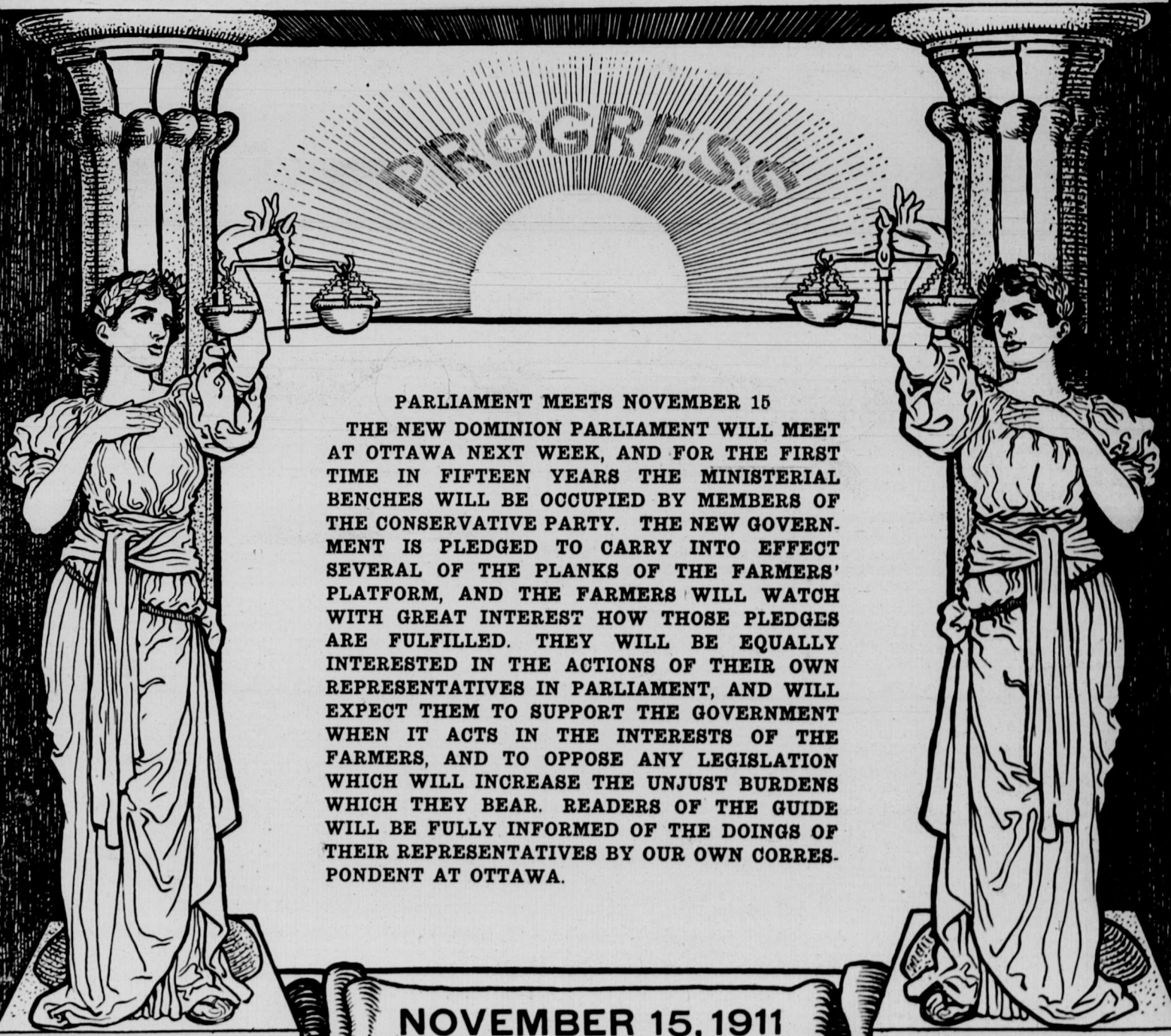

PARLIAMENT MEETS NOVEMBER 15

THE NEW DOMINION PARLIAMENT WILL MEET AT OTTAWA NEXT WEEK, AND FOR THE FIRST TIME IN FIFTEEN YEARS THE MINISTERIAL BENCHES WILL BE OCCUPIED BY MEMBERS OF THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY. 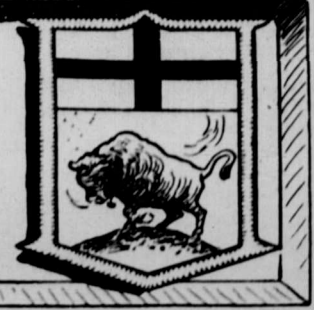
