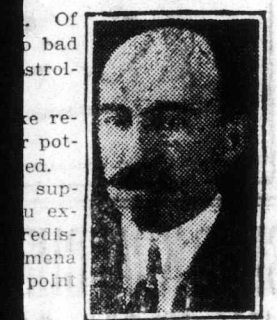

## ONONDAGA COUNCIL

Onondaga, March 23, 1914. The Council met in Township Hall pursuant to call of the Reeve. All the members present. After the reading of the minutes, which were adopted, a communication from A. E. Watts, K.C., regarding sale of \$7,500 Debentures to the Ontario Security Co. was read. The net proceeds at 95 plus 92 days accrued interest, less expense of printing, transfer of bonds and fee advertising, Council was \$7,194.02 which was placed in (Cainville) Bank to the credit of Onondaga Township. The tenders received for the steel work on Taws' and Dixon's bridges, were from the Hamilton Bridge Co., The Hamilton Steel Construction Co., A. Neill and Co., Mitchell; Sarnia Bridge Co. and the Stratford Bridge Co. The first three firms had their representatives in attendance. After a very careful investigation by the Council the contract was given to the Hamilton Steel Construction Co. for the sum of \$1,250. The bridges to be placed as soon as abutments were ready. H. M. Vanderlip, Cainville, and A. S. Winger, Springvale, tendered for the cement work. The tenders were for all material and work except for the reinforcing iron. As both Vanderlip and Winger were very reliable contractors, A. S. Winger's, being the lowest tender, was awarded the contract. The following amendments to By-law No. 246 appoints Mr. Thos. Hunter, Overseer for road beat No. 34; Mr. Peter Preiss for No. 19 and Mr. George McLellan for beat No. 6. A by-law was put though at the last meeting for raising the price for commutation of Statute labor from \$1.00 to \$1.25 per day. The clerk was instructed to mail to each newly appointed Roadmaster the declaration of office with instruction to return same by first mail upon receipt of which, the road lists would be sent. The Council adjourned to meet in regular session at Middleport the 4th of May, 1914.

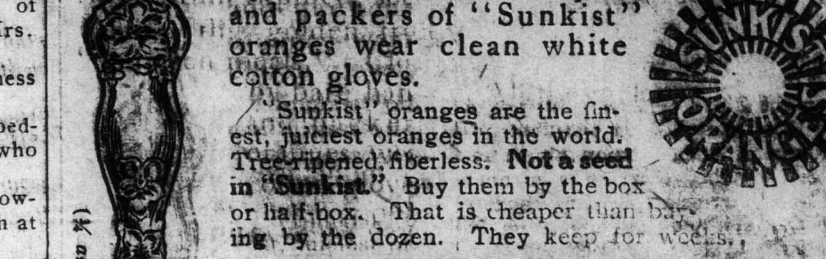
