AN IMMINENT CRISIS.

Caprivi and the Prussian Premier
Do Not Pull Well Together.

ANARCHY AMONG OFFICIALS.

Bismarck Said to Be at the Bottom of
the Affair—His Newspapers Jubilant—
Wilhelm Must Intervene—A Hard Fight
for Caprivi.

Berlin, Oct. 23.—The semi-official
dailies continued until Friday morning to
report the reports of dissensions between
Chancellor Van Caprivi and Count Botho
Zu Eulenburg, Prussian Minister Presi-
dent. All references to a quarrel between
the two statesmen were pronounced as in-
ventions. On Friday and Saturday, how-
ever, the inspired editors were dumb,
although the old reports were repeated
in various forms. The fact that it is a
ministerial crisis suddenly became im-
minent in the minds of the public. It is
making too much of that cabinet feud, are
in most respects telling facts. Eulenburg
protested the treaty. He told the Emperor
that he should resign in case Caprivi's
concessions to Russia in the war
