able to expect a student of the O. A. U.
who has never worked on a farm before to
be as successful at the business as a man

and then taken a full course at the
College, unless the man of 20 years ex-
perience was so confoundedly stubborn
that he would not allow himself to be
taught by a man who has been successful
in his College learning for 20 years.
If he will only add his previous experience
to his College learning he is bound to be
the more successful of the two. I am
satisfied that this reasoning holds good in
testing sight, and 20 years' experience by
the old method, combined with a thorough
college course at the Optical School in
New York, with five years' experience
