The Problem of the Modern Saloon. By REV. JOHNSON HENDERSON."

The growth of the modern saloon

has been of such a character as to force itself on the attention of those who otherwise might disciple the sum of their thoughts. Self defence is sometimes the best cure for a spirit of indifference. The modern saloon has become such a power in the social and political world that it can no longer be overlooked by those who would intelligently measure the forces that aid or retard the development of all that is good among men.

The problem of the salson, at the present time, is a matter of dispute. To some it is merely a question of-personal laberty, and every other consideration is set aside. Others regard the saloon as the creature- of legislation which waits only the passage of a simple law to bring about its suppression. Then again it is reduced to a question of revenue, and the moral factor being entirely eliminated, means are sometimes devised for nursing the saloon into such a healthy condition that it can afford to pay sufficiently for the privilege of existence.

When it sinks into such depths of moral degradation that neitner political expediency of decency can tolerate, the question of the saloon is often made one of geographical location, and the chief aim then is to remove these disagreeable drinking places far enough from churches and favored resident districts as not to interfere with the piety of the one, or the exclusiveness of the other. Reformation of the evil is also sometimes attempted, at least to such an extent that the saloon can secure a certificate of character from the trade that will serve to soothe the troubled conscience of the community.

The great secret of the power of the saloon must be discovered, and a reformation that will ultimately make it impossible for it to maintain an existence must begin at headquarters, and not in the slums. DEATH AT ST. JOHN.


