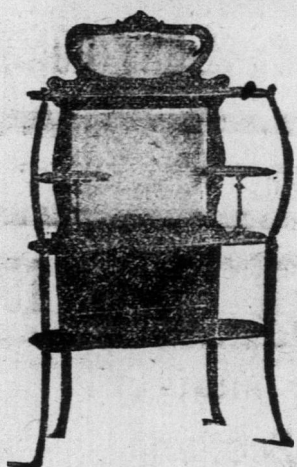

DURAZZO, Albania, To-day. Servian troops have occupied this town. No resistance was offered. It is a port on the Adriatic which Servia desires to obtain and Austria is determined she shall not. Austria is most determined in this intention.

LONDON, To-day. Sir Edward Grey's proposal that Ambassadors of six great Powers—Britain, France, Germany, Russia, Austria-Hungary and Italy—should assemble in one of the Capitals with a view of emphasizing the points arising out of the Balkan war upon which nations are in agreement, it is understood have the support of Germany, France and Russia. Ambassadors will be able to register agreement on principle of such matters as to the future of Albania, disposition of islands of Aegean Sea, opening and closing of Dardanelles. For instance, the Powers apparently are all ready to recognize Albanian independence, and pledge themselves not to seek territorial acquisitions in the Aegean Sea. News as to negotiations between Turkey and Bulgaria is scanty. There is a temporary lull on the battle field. Great secrecy is being maintained regarding the conference at Baghatche where the plenipotentiaries are discussing the terms of peace in a railway car saloon between the opposing lines in battle array.

Cigarette Caused Fire.

A fire occurred between 5 and 6 last evening at the house owned and occupied by Mr. J. Picco on Mullock Street. At 5.30 Mr. Picco's son retired for the day and went to his bed to lay down. He lit a cigarette, and when finished his smoke he unconsciously dropped the "butt" on the bed clothes, which quickly ignited. The other inmates of the house smelled the smoke and, running to the room with buckets of water, quenched the blaze. No alarm was sent in and very little damage was done.

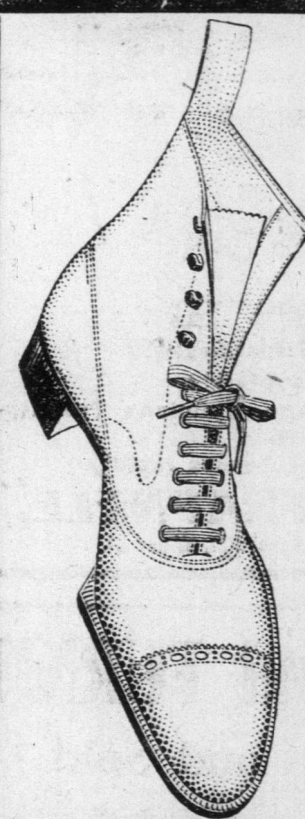
