SEATTLE, Wash., To-day. Six men are dead and 50 are suffer-ing to-day from bullet wounds as a re-sult of the battle yesterday at Ever-ett, Wash., thirty miles north of Se-attle, when 250 members of industrial workers of the world attempted to land in that city from the steamer Verona which had carried them from Seattle. The boat was met by Sheriff Donald McRae of Snohmish County, who, with the police forbade the men to land.
