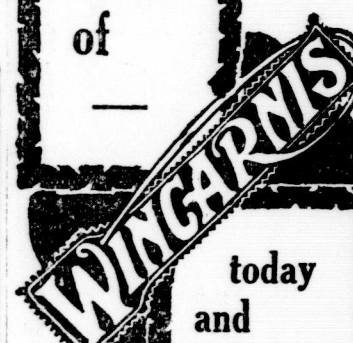

TAKES STAND ON UNION

Hamilton Methodist Conference Hopes to Facilitate Church Federation.

ST. CATHARINES, June 5.—The Hamilton Methodist conference this morning decided to meet next year in Wellington Street Church, Brantford. The final draft of stations will be announced tomorrow. The committee expects an all-night session tonight.

Definite decision on church union and a request for further progress was made this morning in a resolution which was passed by a standing vote.

The resolution urged that this conference memorialize the general conference to declare that if steps to consummate union are not substantially advanced within one year after September 30, 1922, the general conference will then invite the existing union churches and any other evangelical churches in Canada who may desire to form a united church with it to consider the formation of a united church on the existing basis of union, subject to such modifications as existing conditions may then seem to require.

HALIFAX SOLDIER DANGEROUSLY ILL

Halifax, N. S., June 5.—Ralph Myles, the 24-year-old soldier, who was found with a bullet in the vicinity of his heart alongside the dead body of Florence Miles, 19 years old, in a wood here on Friday afternoon, was said at the hospital last night to be in a "dangerous condition." It was thought on Saturday that he would recover. Myles claimed the shooting followed a suicide pact. He stated after being found that he did not wish to live.

THREE PERISH IN CROSSING CRASH

Sherbrooke, Que., June 5.—Alec Doucay, his wife, and 15-year-old daughter, Gladys, are dead, and his son, Patrick, 18 years of age, is seriously injured as the result of a level railway crossing accident, about a mile and a half from Norton Mills on Saturday.

A three-year-old baby, who was in the Doucay car when it was struck by the Montreal-Newport afternoon train, is only slightly injured.

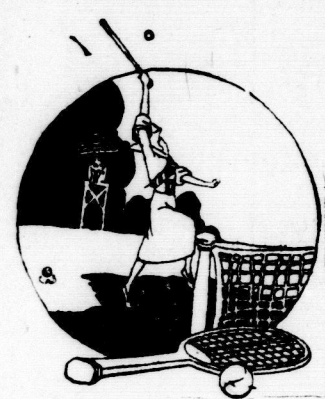

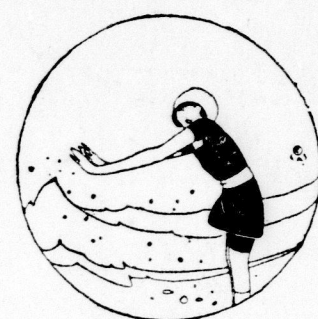
