TOMATO SOUP .- One quart of tomatees or a two-pound can of tomatoes, to which add one quart of water, one-half of a small onion sliced, a piece of butter the size of a hen's egg, in which ruh a large tablespoonful of flour, and hoil slowly one hour. Just before serving strain the soup and ade one pint of scalded milk.

BLACK BEAN SOUP .- One pint of black beans, a small joint or shank of beef, a slice of salt pork. Soak the beans over night, drain off the water and put them into the kettle with the meat and cover with waser. Buil about five hours; strain through the colander. Add the yelks of three hard-boiled eggs and slices of lemon.

Beware of infinitors:

LEMON JUICE and salt will take sputs of iron run from linen, which which should be left in the sun to bleach.

CRULLERS. - One cup sugar, one tablespoonful butter, two eggs, one cup rich milk, three cars flour, mixed with three teaspoonsful Claudian's Superior Baking Powder, one deasthonful salt. Use flour enough to roll and fry in hot lard.

CITRON PUDDING: - Mix one-half pint of cream or rich milk with a table-spoonful of flour until they are perfectly smooth, then add two ounces of fine sugar, a little grated nutmer and three well-beaten eggs, the whites and yelks separately; when thoroughly incorpor-ated, add two ounces of citron cut in slips dredged with flour. Pour the mix-ture into moulds and bake fifteen min-utes in a quick over. Send to the table hot.

INVERNESS EGGS. - Buil four hard take off their shells; make forcemeat with parsley, thyme, breadcrumbs, pepper, salt, butter, chopped anchove and a beaten-up egg; cover the haid eggs with this forcemeat, roll in flour, fire light hours and care. fry a light brown, and serve.




