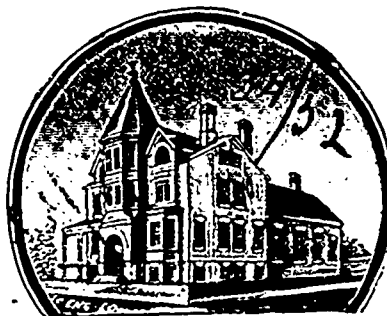

## Household Hints.

**TOMATO SOUP.**—One quart of tomatoes or a two-pound can of tomatoes, to which add one quart of water, one-half of a small onion sliced, a piece of butter the size of a hen's egg, in which rub a large tablespoonful of flour, and boil slowly one hour. Just before serving strain the soup and add one pint of scalded milk.

**BLACK BEAN SOUP.**—One pint of black beans, a small joint or shank of beef, a slice of salt pork. Soak the beans over night, drain off the water and put them into the kettle with the meat and cover with water. Boil about five hours; strain through the colander. Add the yolks of three hard-boiled eggs and slices of lemon.

**Hersford's Acid Phosphate.** Beware of imitations.

LEMON JUICE and salt will take spots of iron rust from linen, which should be left in the sun to bleach.

**CRULLERS.**—One cup sugar, one tablespoonful butter, two eggs, one cup rich milk, three cups flour, mixed with three teaspoonfuls of Cleveland's Superior Baking Powder, one teaspoonful salt. Use flour enough to roll and fry in hot lard.

**CITRON PUDDING.**—Mix one-half pint of cream or rich milk with a tablespoonful of flour until they are perfectly smooth, then add two ounces of fine sugar, a little grated nutmeg and three well-beaten eggs, the whites and yolks separately; when thoroughly incorporated, add two ounces of citron cut in slips dredged with flour. Pour the mixture into moulds and bake fifteen minutes in a quick oven. Send to the table hot.

**INVERNESS EGGS.**—Bail four hard, take off their shells; make forcemeat with parsley, thyme, breadcrumbs, pepper, salt, butter, chopped anchovy and a beaten-up egg; cover the hard eggs with this forcemeat, roll in flour, fry a light brown, and serve.

**DISCOLORATIONS in marble,** which are very unsightly, can be taken out by mixing equal parts of ox-gall and turpentine, and making into a paste with pipe clay. Spread over the surface and let it remain two or three days.

**LEMONS PICKLED.**—Two dozen lemons—pare the yellow rind from them as thin as possible; slit them across at the ends and pack them in dry salt for three days; then lay them to dry in the sun, allowing some of the salt to adhere to them; two days hot sun will be sufficient. Put them in a porcelain-lined kettle with two quarts of vinegar, four ounces of white pepper and white mustard seed mixed, and one grated nutmeg; let them all boil thoroughly together five minutes. Always see that they are well covered with vinegar. This is a superb pickle and beautiful in appearance.

**HOT SLAW.**—Put in a skillet, a piece of butter the size of an egg. Have mixed and stir in three well-beaten eggs with one tablespoonful of flour, the same of sugar, one-half cupful of sweet milk. Chop a head of cabbage if small, a half head if large; pepper and salt it and pour over it a half-cupful of vinegar. Stir in the dressing on the stove and just let it get warm. A head of celery chopped with the cabbage makes it very nice.

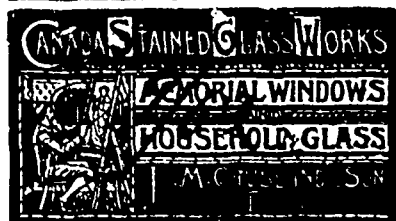

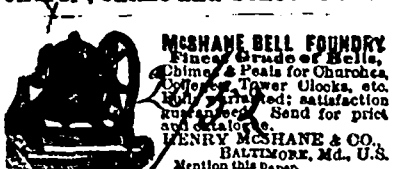
