

**THEIR NEW WAREHOUSES.**

W. J. Gage & Co., Toronto, are making preparations to move from their temporary premises back to their old site on Front St. and hope to accomplish it by October 20th. and to have their factory working by November 1st. Had it not been that the labor troubles seriously delayed building operations, these premises by this time would have been practically completed. Notwithstanding the difficulties of working in temporary premises and having their various departments scattered over the city, Gage & Co. have made and shipped more goods since July 1st than in any other three months of the firm's history, an accomplishment which speaks well for the company organization. The new building on Front St. will possess all the necessary facilities to enable Gage & Co. to improve the process of manufacture and will compare with any premises of a similar class on the continent.

W. J. Gage & Co., Toronto, are building in addition to their Front St. premises, a large factory on Spadina Avenue between King and Adelaide Sts. The lot is 100 x 100 ft. and the building is to consist of four storeys with a total of 80,000 square feet of floor space. The equipment will be of the most approved type and already preparations have been made to install an elevator which will carry a railway lorry from the ground to the top floor enabling it to be loaded or unloaded with the least possible loss of time.
