To gain a diploma in this Grade, candidates must obtain 50 per cent. of the marks assigned in the above groups. Credit will be given for passing in any other group.

Special arrangements will be made as to the Examination in Reading; and a practical exercise in Class-teaching

may be required.

GRADE II.

Same work as in Senior Grade syllabus of the Council of Higher Education; but the following subjects will be compulsory:—

English Grammar, etc.

Geography and History.

Arithmetic and Algebra.

Geometry.

Book-keeping.

Freehand or Geometrical Drawing.

School-management.

Fifty per cent. on an average of the marks assigned in the above subjects must be obtained, and fifty per cent. must be obtained in each of the first three groups; but in Freehand Drawing or Geometrical Drawing forty per cent. will be sufficient.

The arrangements as to Reading, Recitation and Class-teaching, will be the same as for Grade III.

GRADE I.

Syllabus same as that of Senior Grade of Council of Higher Education; but the following groups will be compulsory:—

English Grammar, etc., Geography and History, Arithmetic and Algebra, Geometry, Mensuration, Mechanics or Navigation, French or Latin, Book-keeping, Freehand or Geometrical Drawing, School-Management.

Girls may take Domestic Economy instead of Mechanics or Navigation.

Sixty per cent. of marks assigned to above must be made in all groups except Mechanics, Freehand or Geometrical Drawing where forty per cent., and French or Latin where
