

BELGIUM

In 1988, all imports of refrigerated brussels sprouts, cauliflower and carrots were from the EEC. Statistics for 1989 confirm this trend. Smaller quantities of sweet corn, green peas and beans are imported from countries outside the community, principally from the Eastern European countries.

For information purposes, there are some 20 local producers of frozen vegetables against a total of 7 importers for these same products.
