

## CHAPTER IV

### Special Types of Assistance

#### ARTICLE 4

On request, the requested Administration shall provide the requesting Administration with the following information:

- (a) whether goods which are imported into the territory of the requesting Contracting Party have been lawfully exported from the territory of the requested Contracting Party;
- (b) whether goods which are exported from the territory of the requesting Contracting Party have been lawfully imported into the territory of the requested Contracting Party and the customs procedure, if any, under which the goods have been placed.

#### ARTICLE 5

On request, the requested Administration shall, to the extent possible, maintain surveillance over and provide the requesting Administration with information and intelligence on:

- (a) persons known to have committed a Customs offence or suspected of being about to commit a Customs offence in the territory of the requesting Contracting Party, particularly those moving into and out of the territory of the requested Contracting Party;
- (b) goods, either in transport or in storage, known to have been used or suspected of being used to commit a Customs offence in the territory of the requesting Contracting Party;
- (c) means of transport known to have been used or suspected of being used to commit a Customs offence in the territory of the requesting Contracting Party.
