As we pursue this important task, we appreciate the attitude of our American friends. The total absence of any improper interference is only what we would expect from a trusted neighbor. It should be an example for others.

INDEED THERE IS MUCH IN OUR RELATIONSHIP THAT OTHERS COULD EMULATE. WE LIVE IN A WORLD WHERE TRUST BETWEEN NEIGHBORS IS IN WOEFULLY SHORT SUPPLY AND WHERE SUSPICION AND CYNICISM ARE THE PRINCIPAL INGREDIENTS IN INTERNATIONAL DEALINGS. How satisfying in such a climate to know that in Canada-United States relations a simple phone call between Ottawa and Washington is often enough to resolve a serious PROBLEM AND THAT A HANDSHAKE CAN SERVE AS WELL AS A COMPLEX TREATY.

WE CANADIANS WANT TO KEEP THINGS THAT WAY; I AM SURE YOU AMERICANS DO TOO. AND WE WILL.

MR. SECRETARY, AND HONOURED GUESTS, I WOULD LIKE TO PROPOSE A TOAST TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE WARMTH AND FRIENDSHIP SHARED BY CANADIANS IN ALL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY WITH THEIR FELLOWS IN THE UNITED STATES.
