Bill S-15, An Act to amend the Department of Industry, Trade and Commerce Act, as reported (without amendment) from the Standing Committee on Finance, Trade and Economic Affairs, was concurred in at the report stage.

Bill S-17, An Act to amend the Explosives Act, as reported (without amendment) from the Standing Committee on National Resources and Public Works, was concurred in at the report stage.

Mr. Sharp for Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale), seconded by Mr. Drury, moved,—That the Bill be now read a third time and do pass.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the motion, it was agreed to.
