**Mr. Hawkes:** Mr. Speaker, I do not think there is any responsibility more onerous on members than the casting of a vote in division. I have some doubts about the wisdom of standing up 24 times, but when the results of the last vote were announced, there was a total of 38 members present in the chamber on the opposition side and I suspect that there were fewer members on our side than the vote count would indicate.

If we fall into sloppy habits in relation to votes, we could get the House and the integrity of Parliament into trouble down the road. I would suggest that members should be present in the chamber to hear the motion read and they should remain in the chamber until the vote is announced or they should not vote.

I would hope that on all sides of the House we might respect that set of principles so that we can have clarity on the results of the votes.
