

The hour devoted to Private and Public Bills having expired;

The House resumed the consideration in Committee of the Whole of the proposed Resolution to amend the Technical Education Act.

(In the Committee)

The following Resolution was adopted:—

Resolved, That the Technical Education Act be amended to provide that any balance of the ten million dollars appropriated under this Act unexpended on the 31st March, 1929, shall remain available during any one or more of the five succeeding fiscal years, but no portion thereof shall be paid to any province after the 31st March, 1934.

Resolution to be reported.

The said Resolution was reported, read the second time and concurred in.

Mr. Heenan then, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. 34, An Act to amend the Technical Education Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

A Message was received from the Senate acquainting this House that the Senate had adopted the following Resolution:—

That it is expedient that Parliament do approve of the General Treaty of the Renunciation of War, which was signed at Paris, on the twenty-seventh day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, on behalf of His Majesty for the Dominion of Canada by the plenipotentiary named therein, and that this House do approve of the same.

and requesting the Commons to unite with the Senate in the approval of the above mentioned Treaty.
