this Kingdom may secure to itself all the Advantages that could have arose from the Posessiplion of Louisburg, at a less Expence than would have been requisite for keeping so large a Fortress in Repair, and defending it with a proper Garrison.

Settling of the Cape Sable Shore, will undoubtedly make a Winter's Cod-Fishery practicable, and may soon become more considerable than any that ever has been prosecuted,
and as the Fish caught and cured in that Season exceed all others, they will of course come to
a better Market in all Parts of the World.
