melâsuk, Bridgeport, N. S.; abundance.
memkâtê, Cape St. George; the small field.
menkuskâk, Seaweed Road, P. E. Island.
mentceboogwek, Middle River, Pictou Co.
menabank, Nappan.
menakwêš, St. John, the changeable, weak place.
menakwêškawî, Island Point.
menskwâk, Chester; (2) place near Liverpool.
menoodek, Minudie; a small bay.
mesadek, Long Island.
mesebakun, Sambro Point; the constant mocker.
mesegwôl, it bleeds freely.
meskêk-um-pudas, the "Bottomless Lake," Portage, P. E. I.; the deep pond.
mespâk, Cape Mispek.
migtêtcwægatic, Boisdale, C. B.
mijeogun, St. Lawrence.

milesêk, Lingan.
milpagêtc, Lake on Tangier River; an eight-sided dish.
mittigâtê, Meander River, Newport.
minegêtc, Cape North, P. E. I. the little island.
minegoo, one name for P. E. I.; the island.
minegooskêk, Third Lake on Port Medway River; place of the little island.
ministugek, Barrington.
miskoolê, [*munuskoolê*], Miscouche and Muddy Creek, P. E. I.; the little grassy island.
moglâkadik, Big Bras d'or Lake; place of brant.
moglâkâtêk, L'Ardoise, C. B.
mokpâk [*malpâk*], Malpec; large salt lake; deep-sea water.
mogulawijik, Port Hill, P. E. I. multitudes of brant.
molabokek, Mabou.
molabokekwi-kômâ, Mabou Harbour.
molabokekêtcêtc, Little Mabou.
molînastogekêtcêtc, place near Little Mabou.
moocanuk, the string of islands near Jeddore; haunt of the sea-duck.
