An Act to amend the Railway Act, 1903.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as fol-Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :-

1. Section 227 of The Railway Act, 1903, is amended by 1903, c. 58, s. 5 striking out the word "or" in the third line and substituting therefor the word "and," and by adding after the word "expedient" at the end of the section the words, "but wherever in any such portion of a city, town or village a railway crosses a highway at rail-level, the said speed of ten miles an hour 10 shall in no event be exceeded, unless the Company provides, by a watchman or gates at such crossing, protection against approaching trains for persons using the highway."
